



SSA CONSTITUTION

Street Sports Association (SSA)

1. Name

Your team/facility/sessions will be affiliated with Street Sports Association (SSA).

2. Aims and objectives

The aims and objectives of the club will be:

- To offer coaching and competitive opportunities in Street Sports and Calisthenics
- To above all promote Street Sports and Calisthenics
- To ensure a duty of care to all members of the clubs/facilities/sessions/affiliates and members
- To provide all its services in a way that is fair to everyone
- To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment

3. Affiliation

Affiliation should consist of SSA coaches, members and a facility/team/individual affiliate (whom ever name is stated on the affiliates registration form).

All members will be subject to the regulations of the constitution and by joining the Association will be deemed to accept these regulations and codes of conduct that the team/facility/sessions has adopted and the policies and rules of the Street Sports Association.

Memberships will be decided by facility/team/individual who is affiliated with the SSA

4. Affiliation fees

Affiliation fees will be set monthly or annually depending on agreement made between facility/team/individual and the SSA and determined at the Annual General Meeting.

Fees will be paid by monthly or annual subscription with a minimum of 12 months registration.

5. Representative

Each facility/team/individual will have representative who will put forward any decision making votes for their members to the SSA as all decisions of the future of the movement go to majority vote of the affiliates, their members and the board.

6. *SSA and your involvement*

The SSA board will be responsible for adopting new policy, codes of conduct and rules that affect the organisation of the association, as put forward by the affiliates

The SSA board will have powers to appoint area affiliates as necessary and appoint advisers to the affiliates as necessary to fulfil and assist in the growth of their business.

The SSA board will be responsible for disciplinary hearings of affiliates who infringe the SSA rules/regulations/constitution. The SSA board will be responsible for taking any action of suspension or discipline following such hearings after mutual agreement of affiliates and board members alike.

7. Finance

All SSA monies will be banked in an account held in the name of the Street Sports Association.

The SSA board will be responsible for the finances of the association.

8. Quarterly affiliate meetings

Notice of the Quarterly Affiliate Meeting (QAM) will be given by the SSA. Not less than 21 clear days' notice to be given to all affiliates.

The affiliates will receive a report from the SSA and actions to be taken to take the movement forward.

The SSA has the right to call Extraordinary Affiliate Meetings (EAMs) outside the QAM. Procedures for EAMs will be the same as for the QAM. For reasons that will include growth and training updates.

9. Discipline and appeals

All complaints regarding the behaviour of any persons within the SSA or their affiliates should be submitted in writing.

The SSA board will meet to hear complaints within 21 days of a complaint being lodged. The SSA has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action including the termination of affiliation.

The outcome of a disciplinary hearing should be notified in writing to the person who lodged the complaint and the person against whom the complaint was made within 21 days of the hearing. There will be the right of appeal to the SSA following disciplinary action being announced. The SSA should consider the appeal within 14 days of receiving the appeal.

10. Dissolution

A resolution to dissolve the association can only be passed at an QAM or EAM.

In the event of dissolution, any assets of the club that remain will become the property of Street Sports International Limited.

11. Amendments to the constitution

The constitution will only be changed through agreement of the SSA board.

12. Declaration

I hereby adopt and accept this constitution as a current operating guide regulating the actions of the SSA and their affiliates.
